Dear Residents,

We are in the midst of a campaign. Missiles have been fired on Ashdod, some have hit and resulted in damages and unfortunately there have been injuries - including a serious injury. It's been proven beyond a doubt - **Appropriate behavior saves lives** Follow instructions issued by the Home Front Command as published in the media.

Public shelters are open Residents of condominiums are asked to leave intercom doors and common shelters open.

Iron Dome does an outstanding job but it is not hermetic. We are still obliged to act wisely, not to be complacent, to make sure that all household members know how and where the protected space is and to follow all rules.
